

Invitation to apply for the Deutschlandstipendium 2024/2025

As part of the national scholarship programme¹, the Neubrandenburg University of Applied Sciences invites applications for its Deutschlandstipendium scholarships for the 2024/2025 winter semester.

All students currently enrolled at the Neubrandenburg University of Applied Sciences and students about to start studying at the Neubrandenburg University of Applied Sciences can apply online.

Selection criteria

The scholarships are awarded primarily based on academic achievement and aptitude of the applicants. A statement of purpose is very important. Special achievements, awards and prizes, previous employment and work placements as well as social commitment, challenging personal and family backgrounds and commitment to non-academic activities and higher education policy are also taken into consideration.

Application period 12 July 2024 to 18 August 2024

Funding period 1 September 2024 to 31 August 2025

Funding total €300.00 a month

Important information

The scholarship is paid monthly and is granted as an allowance that is not paid back. The
scholarship is not means-tested and can be combined with funding provided by the Federal
Training Assistance Act (BAföG). However, a student who is already receiving other material
funding that is also dependent on aptitude and achievement amounting to €30.00 or more a
month cannot receive a Deutschlandstipendium.

¹The Deutschlandstipendium scholarships are awarded as part of a funding programme of the Federal Ministry of Education and Research that is based on the Scholarship Programme Act (StipG) of the German government. The Federal Scholarship Programme Regulation (StipV) and the policy of the Neubrandenburg University of Applied Sciences on awarding scholarships apply within the national scholarship programme. - There is no legal entitlement to the awarding of a scholarship. The decision about awarding the scholarships is made by the scholarship selection committee of the University.
- Providing false information in the application process leads to immediate exclusion from the selection process.

Online application procedure

The application is made for the field of study in which the student is or will be enrolled. To make your application on the online portal, you must submit the following documents by uploading as attachments:

- a statement of purpose no longer than two A4 pages
- CV in tabular format
- the university entrance qualification certificate; for international certificates, a translation indicating equivalence to the German system and conversion to the German grading system
- if applicable, evidence of a special qualification that entitles the student to study in the course at the Neubrandenburg University of Applied Sciences
- for applicants to a place in a Master's course, the certificate for the undergraduate qualification and, if applicable, additional evidence of achievements as defined in the admission and selection requirements for the Master's course
- if applicable, evidence of previous study achievements
- information about whether the applicant is already receiving funding
- if applicable, certificates relating to work placements and employment as well as evidence of special awards and prizes, other skills and further engagement.

If the application documents are not in German or English, officially certified translations into German must be attached.

Applications are made online only. Online applications that are not submitted by the deadline or that are incorrect or incomplete will not be considered in the selection process.
